Expression of Interest for Developing a Program of YES

Youth Affairs Department, Government of Sindh in collaboration and partnership with the Habib University Foundation (H.U.F.), is initiating a project titled “YES” – “Youth Empowering Spaces” – an innovative youth development framework aspiring to create inspiring learning and growing spaces and to provide youth with opportunities to become personally, socially and economically empowered. YES recognizes empowerment as a multidimensional process enabling youth to gain personal power and confidence to manage and improve their own lives and the lives of their families and communities in a conscious, proactive and self controlled way.

What Services are Required?

YES is planning to launch a program titled ‘EYES’ – ‘Engage Youth for Empowering Self’. The program aims at facilitating youth to enhance their self image, attain skills to effectively manage their emotions, nurture their critical thinking and decision making skills, acquire skills for self management and learn to live in harmony with others. In order to engage a large number of youth in the program, YES is planning to develop a core team of young facilitators who can work with their peers.

In this context, YES is looking for youth development/empowerment/training organizations who could work with YES team of Habib University Foundation for the following deliverables

- Reviewing and enriching the framework and plans developed by YES team for EYES.
- Design, deliver and certify a capacity building program for young facilitators to help them enhance their knowledge and skills for the following:
 - Enhancing self confidence as youth facilitators
 - Effective facilitation skills
 - Planning the learning sessions
 - Conducting effective learning sessions for youth to keep them alive and energized
 - Engaging youth in reflective and thought provoking activities
 - Assessing the learning of participants
 - Engaging participants with diverse interests, skills and styles
 - Building a thorough understanding of the content of EYES
 - Young facilitators training program will be of 5 days from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. held at the Institute for Advancing Careers and Talents, Malir. The program is expected to be held in September 2011.
- Supporting youth facilitators in the field by visiting the sessions conducted by them (a few sessions).

Who Could Apply?

Habib University Foundation invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from organizations and / or individuals interested in working with the Foundation for developing EYES.

National Organizations meeting the following eligibility criteria could apply:

- Functional and operational for the last 3 years.
- Experience of working in the above mentioned area.
- Have worked on similar projects and can share examples
- Has a competent team to undertake work and deliver as per given timelines.
- Willing to work as a team with the Foundation through collaboration and exchange of ideas

Individuals meeting the following criteria are also eligible to apply:

- Possess relevant skills for designing and developing such a program and can demonstrate it.
- Have at least three years of experience of working in the above mentioned area.
- Must be able to share relevant work assignments undertaken in the past.
- Possess relevant infrastructure to undertake the work on its own

Interested eligible organizations or individuals may submit EOI with the following details and portfolio.
