## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR IDENTIFYING LEARNING ACTIVITIES FOR ILEAD CURRICULUM

Date: February 16, 2011

iLEAD - Inspiring Leadership, Empowerment and Development in Youth Collectivism, Sharing and Togetherness is an innovative and first of its kind youth development program that aims at facilitating leadership, personal development, and active citizenship in youth from Hyderabad and Karachi, through sports and community service. iLEAD is a public-private partnership program between the Youth Affairs Department, Government of Sindh and Habib University Foundation (H.U.F.), with technical support provided by the British Council, Pakistan. iLEAD is looking for organizations and / or individuals to assist them in designing and developing a Youth Leadership Training Program for its partner institutes' Sports Youth Councils. The requirements and scope of the program are identified below:

### What Needs to be Developed?

Learning activities based on the themes of the iLEAD curriculum need to be identified, designed and documented. The organization and / or individual is expected to undertake the following key deliverables:

- Researching learning activities and pedagogical ideas under the following themes of iLEAD Curriculum
  - Exploring self and Goal setting
  - Emotional Management
  - Critical thinking
  - Decision making
  - Assertive behavior
  - Team building and conflict resolution
- Designing learning activities for iLEAD Curriculum under the above mentioned themes
- Documenting the learning activities properly with instructions for teachers.

### Who Can Apply?

Habib University Foundation invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from organizations and / or individuals interested in working for the development of a youth leadership program. Organizations and / or individuals that have experience in the field of youth development are encouraged to apply. They should meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Functional and operational for the last 2-3 years.
- Experience of working in the above mentioned area.
- Has worked on similar projects and can share examples.
- Ability to undertake research, develop content, outline and modules in the areas highlighted above.
- Willing to work as a team with the Foundation through collaboration and exchange of ideas.

### Individuals meeting the following criteria are also eligible to apply:

- Possess relevant skills for designing and developing the website and can readily demonstrate these skills.
- Has at least three years of experience of working in the field of youth development.
- Must be able to share relevant work assignments undertaken in the past.
- Possess relevant infrastructure to undertake the work on his/her own.

### What Needs to be Submitted?

Interested eligible organizations or individuals may submit EOI with the following details:

- A letter expressing the interest for working with the organization
- Individual/Company profile highlighting the strengths for undertaking the assignment and examples of relevant work done.
- A small proposal describing how will you undertake the work, what will be the timelines and what will be the charges of your service (approximate).

**Deadline:** The last date of EOI submission is February 24, 2010.
